

PRE-CAMP HEALTH SCREENING 2021

Dear Camp Families:

In an effort to minimize illness at camp we ask that you check on the health of your camper(s) daily beginning 10 days prior to camp. The best camp session starts with healthy campers and this begins at home.

Please indicate if your camper has any of the following symptoms prior to camp and record their temperature daily. Please fill out a new sheet for each camper and make sure to bring it on camper drop-off day. If any temperature or symptoms are present, please have your camper evaluated by a licensed health care provider and contact info@campkita.com for further guidance. Each camper (and staff) is required to provide proof of a negative PcR test as close to 72 hours prior to arrival to camp OR have proof of full vaccination. Proof of which needs to be provided along with this document.
